PRESIDENT'S REPORT

GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

- Chef Wally has resigned. We have entered into a short term agreement with Michael Lopez' company to manage the day to day kitchen operations and oversee special events. Contracting with an outside company to manage kitchen operations is a new concept for the club. We agreed to this arrangement on a test basis to see how it works out and a large part of our reasoning was the familiarity Michael Lopez has with our kitchen and clientele.
- Grill room chairs have been ordered and are scheduled for delivery around mid-April. The chairs were custom built. The chairs in the grill room will have arms while the chairs in the private grill room will not have arms.
- The pavers for the north bathroom have arrived and will be installed soon.
- Tony will be working on building up the density of the fairways.
